Drug class, route, frequency, dose, and treatment dates matter.

RESPIRATORY FIELD NOTES

VERIFY EACH ROUTE

RESCUE	Intermittent bronchodilator Intermittent inhalational or oral bronchodilator therapy can support 10 percent.	DAILY	Daily controller treatment Daily bronchodilator therapy or inhalational anti-inflammatory medication can support 30 percent.
COURSES	Systemic steroid courses At least three courses per year of oral or parenteral corticosteroids can support 60 percent.	HIGH DOSE	Daily systemic therapy Daily systemic high-dose corticosteroids or immunosuppressive medication can support 100 percent.

An inhaled corticosteroid is not the same as a systemic oral or injected corticosteroid.
