NEURO	Peripheral neuropathy Identify the affected nerve, side, severity, chemotherapy exposure, and competing causes.	SCAR	Scars Document location, size, pain, instability, adherence, and functional impact.
LYMPH	Lymphedema Use measurements, clinical findings, prescribed compression, infection history, and function.	FATIGUE	Fatigue Distinguish ordinary tiredness from a diagnosed disability or a symptom rated within another condition.
COGN	Cognitive effects Use neuropsychological testing and clinical attribution for treatment-related cognitive impairment.	MENTAL	Mental health Document a separate diagnosis, occupational and social impairment, and nexus to cancer or treatment.
BONE	Bone loss Use DEXA, fractures, treatment history, and a medical link when therapy causes skeletal effects.	ORGAN	Organ dysfunction Evaluate renal, cardiac, pulmonary, endocrine, reproductive, bowel, and bladder effects under the correct criteria.
