DIGESTIVE CLAIM FILE

30%	No nutritional deficiencies Chronic diarrhea is managed by a medically prescribed diet without nutritional deficiencies.	50%	Deficiencies plus systemic findings Document laboratory deficits, pancreatic or lactase insufficiency, and systemic manifestations or villous atrophy.
80%	Wasting and activity limits Show weight loss causing wasting, anemia, systemic effects, and weakness interfering with daily activities.	COMPARE	DC 7328 note When malabsorption is predominant, use the greater evaluation between DC 7328 and DC 7355.
