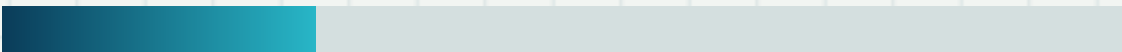

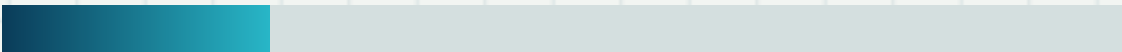

THE DIRECT-SERVICE-CONNECTION TEST

ALL THREE ELEMENTS MUST BE SUPPORTED

1

CURRENT DIAGNOSIS

Establish the current hearing or tinnitus disability.

2

IN-SERVICE EVENT

Document hazardous noise, acoustic trauma, onset, or another relevant event.

3

MEDICAL NEXUS

Use a reasoned opinion connecting the current disability to the in-service element.

FILE

COMPLETE HISTORY

Reconcile onset, service records, later testing, and post-service noise exposure.
