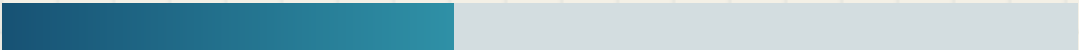

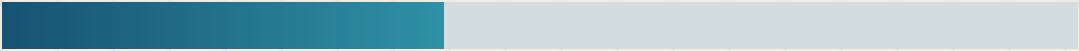

THE DIRECT-SERVICE-CONNECTION TEST

ALL THREE ELEMENTS MUST BE SUPPORTED

1

CURRENT DIAGNOSIS

Identify the current diagnosed disability and the affected joint or spinal region.

2

IN-SERVICE EVENT

Document injury, symptoms, onset, or another event during qualifying service.

3

MEDICAL NEXUS

Use a reasoned opinion linking the current condition to the in-service element.

FILE

COMPLETE HISTORY

Reconcile service records, lay evidence, post-service injuries, treatment, and symptom progression.
